If you are travelling to Tanzania you will need 2 blank adjacent pages in your passport and it must be valid for at least 6 months after your return date in order to clear immigration.

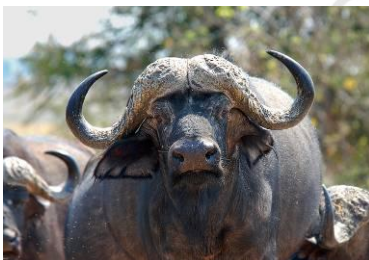
DETAILED ITINERARY

Day 1

Depart London Heathrow on the Kenya Airways flight to Nairobi, International (overnight)

Day 2

Depart Nairobi, International on the Kenya Airways flight to Kilimanjaro.



On arrival into Nairobi at 06:30 you will connect with your 07:30 onward flight to Kilimanjaro. On arrival at 08:30 you will be met by a representative of Nomad Tanzania and driven to Arusha Coffee Lodge where you will stop off for coffee, and you can freshen up a bit after your flight and collect picnics. You will then be driven to Arusha airport for your scheduled flight to Manyara airstrip (13.00/13.25). You will be met by your private guide from Nomad Tanzania and driven to Lemala Ngorongoro camp where you will spend two nights on a full board basis.

Lemala Ngorongoro

Lemala Ngorongoro is a new intimate camp on the rim of the crater offering luxury accommodation under canvas in large spacious tents with wooden platform and rugs. Each tent has 2 large single beds or a king size double bed with thick duvets for warmth and comfort, a heater to warm the tent, and a private bathroom that includes a dressing area, flush loo, shower and basin with running water. There are only 8 tents in the private concession to ensure privacy and seclusion. The mess area is beautifully furnished with grand sofas, lamps, book and corner cabinets in old wood, chests and rugs. Meals are served al fresco or inside the mess and all guests are invited to sit together with the naturalist at dinner time. Laundry and house beverages (wine, beer, spirits, soda, water, tea and coffee) are included at meal time. Lemala Ngorongoro offers great charm and luxury in a delightful prime location on the rim of the crater.

Day 4

Serengeti Safari Camp

Today you will set off with picnics and be driven to the southern Serengeti where you will spend three nights at Serengeti Safari Camp on a full board basis. You will remain with your private guide/vehicle whilst staying at Serengeti Safari Camp.



Though the Serengeti park boundaries officially define the Serengeti, the ecosystem goes way beyond these limits; we call this the Greater Serengeti. It's a giant picture of wild Tanzania - masses of animals, contrasting landforms, and tribal peoples. We roam around the lot in true nomad fashion. The camps are semi nomadic - they won't move during a safari - but they're actually on a wide orbit, shadowing the Migration so each group, with it's professional driver-guide and private four-wheel drive vehicle, are as close to a million wildebeest as possible. While a full day from dawn till dusk can be spent on your own adventures, the wandering camps are sociable because they're shared - but never with more than eight guests, staying in classic safari style. Each luxury bed tent sits alone on a beautiful patch of Africa, a stroll away from a candlelit canvas mess for lively campaign evenings. The Serengeti Safari Camp offers the traditional mobile-tented camp located as close as possible to the wildebeest herds. Operating on a shared use basis, the camp will have been positioned before arrival in likely proximity to the predicted migratory path. Each couple or group of guests is guaranteed their own private 4x4 vehicle with an experienced guide throughout their stay, allowing complete flexibility to tailor their safari to their own particular interests. Game drives, picnics and cookout breakfasts are a highlight of many guests' Serengeti Safari Camp experiences and depending on the camp location, are offered wherever possible.

Day 7

Serian Maswa

Today you will be driven to Ndutu Airstrip where you will say good bye to your private guide and your new guide from Serian will take you on from here. You will stay with this private



guide/vehicle throughout your stay at Serian.
Alex Walker is very well known for offering a true safari experience away from the crowds. In Maswa (in the South of the Serengeti) he has private use of a vast reserve where he can offer walking, night drives along with village trips with the local tribes of the area and they can even show you their hunting methods if it is something that interests you. It is quite a unique set-up and the guiding is exceptional. There is a great atmosphere and experience on offer that none of the other Serengeti camps can get close to.

Alex's operation can keep you more than occupied with sleep outs, walks, drives, migration drives, Lake Eyasi, Hadzabe hunts and culture excursions, fantastic for those of us who want to do something different.

The Southern Serengeti is dominated by vast apparently infinite short grass plains, the Maswa woodlands to the south west and the dramatic Gol Mountains and open plains of Loliondo to the east. The southern plains are at their best between mid December and late May when this whole area comes alive as millions of wildebeest move onto the plains in search of the fresh green grass after the first rains. There is no need to go to the busier areas of the Serengeti ecosystem to see the migration during these months.

A low use area you can drive all day and hardly see another human. At times almost wading through vast concentrations of plains games or sitting quietly, close to an isolated water pan way out in the plains, almost certainly home to its own resident group of lion or cheetah or wild dog and, with patience a very likely amphitheatre for some sort of predator action to play out.

Day 11



Lamai Serengeti Camp

Today your guide will drop you off at Ndotu airstrip for your flight up to Kogatende (time to be confirmed). You will be met and driven to camp, where you will spend four nights on a full board basis, with shared game drives.

Lamai Serengeti Camp is located in the northern Serengeti, set within the iconic Kogakuria kopjes with views out over the Mara River Valley and Lamai Wedge. With just 12 tents, split between two separate camps: the Main Camp consists of 8 tents, and the smaller Private Camp of 4 tents. All the tents have their own private & roomy verandas spread within the rocks and all have been sited with spectacular views. Each camp has its own private bar and dining area, with adjoining library and map room and its own natural rock swimming pool. All rooms have 24hr power and en-suite bathrooms with hot and cold running water, flush toilets, inside bath and outdoor shower.

Activities offered are game drives, guided walks, bush picnics and sundowners. There is also a good chance of Mara River crossings (from July to October).

Today your guide will drive you to Kogatende airstrip for your flight to Kilimanjaro (10.50/13.30). We have not added in the cost of a private guide/vehicle for this day as it is not worth it for your game drive transfer to the airstrip so you may well share with other guests this morning.

On arrival at Kilimanjaro, you will be met and driven to Kia Lodge where you will have a day room. You can have lunch, relax by the pool and freshen up before your transfer to Kilimanjaro for

your journey home.

Country Notes: In order to clear Zanzibar immigration you are required to have at

least 3 blank adjacent pages in your passport and it must be valid for at least 6 months after your return date. Failure to meet these regulations may result in refused entry.

Following a severe outbreak of yellow fever in Northern Uganda, ALL visitors to Zanzibar will be required to present a valid yellow fever certificate of vaccination on entry.

Those requiring a visa (including all British citizens) are now advised to have at least two adjacent blank pages available in their passport on arrival; your passport must be valid for at least 6 months after your return date. Failure to meet this requirement could mean that entry will be refused.

Please note that light aircrafts carry very strict luggage limits of 15kg per person and include hand luggage.

Yellow Fever certificate

Health Surveillance Desks which were removed in 2001, have been reinstalled at all Tanzanian borders, ports and international airports.

All clients travelling to Tanzania from Europe via or transiting through an endemic country will need to show a Yellow Fever vaccination certificate to clear Tanzanian immigration. For example, if you are flying on British Airways or Kenya Airways into Nairobi and then on to Kilimanjaro by charter or with Kenya Airways or Precision Air, you will need a certificate.

The Yellow Fever Endemic Zone in Africa includes Senegal, Gambia, Guinea Bissau, Sierra Leone, Liberia, Cote D'Ivoire, Burkina Faso, Ghana, Nigeria, Mali, Niger, Chad, Central African Republic, Togo, Benin, Sao Tome, and Principe, Cameroon, Gabon, Congo, Democratic Republic of Congo, Tanzania, Angola, Zambia, Uganda, Kenya, Rwanda, Burundi, Ethiopia, Somali, S
